



- <u>Community Room</u> Holds up to 60 people and is equipped with a stove, refrigerator/freezer, microwave and kitchen area. Most rentals that take place here are for birthday parties, baptisms, anniversary parties, small weddings, baby showers and bridal showers.
- <u>Gymnasium</u> Holds over 200 people. This area is mostly used for basketball, volleyball, dances and big receptions. There is a stage area that is also available with rental of the gymnasium. Our sound system is available for use at an additional charge.
 *Additional janitorial fees may apply for gymnasium rentals.
- <u>Studio B</u> Holds up to 30 people and is arranged in a dance studio setting and atmosphere. This
 room can be used for small parties, sports-oriented activities or meetings.

Construction on what was the front 9 of Little Creek Golf Course has been complete with some minor landscaping to finish in the Spring. The park now includes a pavilion, walking path, bridges, 2-5yr old play structure, parking and landscaping improvements. We are happy to announce Jackson Township was awarded another DCNR grant for Phase 2 of the park so construction will continue in 2020! Phase 2 will include multipurpose fields, pickleball court, basketball court, ADA access, 5-12yr play structure, landscaping, signage and other site related improvements. The back 9 will continue to operate as a golf course running April-October.



Slow Cooker Pulled Pork



Provided by Delish.com YIELDS: 8 SERVINGS PREP TIME: 0 HOURS 10 MINS TOTAL TIME: 6 HOURS 0 MINS

INGREDIENTS

- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 3/4 c. ketchup
- 3 tbsp.
- tomato paste
- 1/4 c.
- apple cider vinegar
- 1 tsp.
- paprika
- 1 tsp.
- garlic powder
- 1 tsp.
- mustard powder
- 1 tsp.
- cumin
- 1
- (3- to 4-lb.) pork shoulder, trimmed of excess fat
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- Coleslaw, for serving
- Buns, for serving

DIRECTIONS

Combine onion, ketchup, tomato paste, apple cider vinegar and spices in the bowl of a slow cooker. Season pork shoulder all over with salt and pepper then add to slow cooker, covering it with ketchup mixture.

Cover and cook until very tender (the meat should fall apart easily with a fork!), on HIGH for 5 to 6 hours or on LOW for 8 to 10 hours.

Remove pork from slow cooker and transfer to bowl. Shred with two forks and toss with juices from the slow cooker. Serve on buns with coleslaw.


